She graduated in 2016 and received the Emerging Artist Award of the Province of Carinthia. In 2017 and 2018 Struger exhibited in Vienna, Klagenfurt and Daegu, South Korea (solo), Budapest (double) and Berlin, Auckland, Klagenfurt, Graz (group). Céline Struger is based in Vienna, but recently lived and worked in France, the Netherlands, Germany, Hungary, Canada and South Korea.
